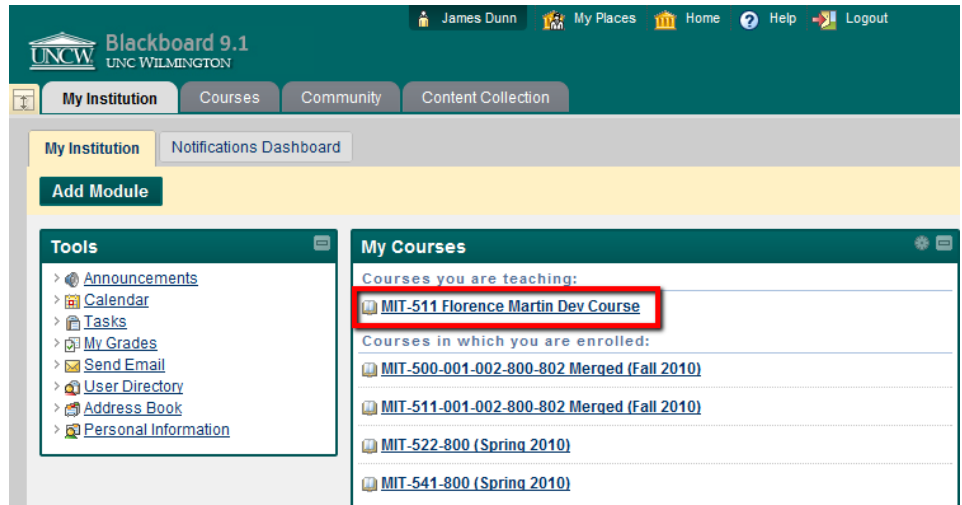


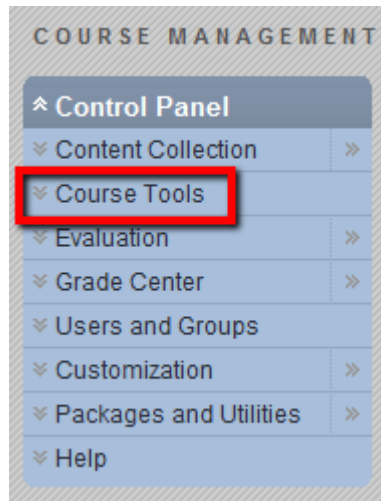
[Another Way of...] Grading Journals in Blackboard 9.1

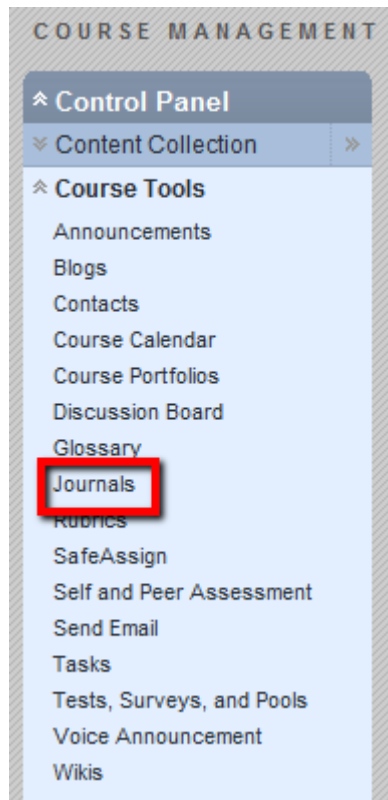
1 Enter your Blackboard Course.



2 In the lower-left corner of the page, click on Course Tools.



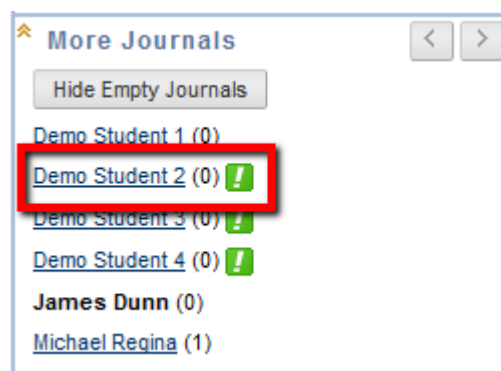
3 Click on Journals.



4 Find the journal assignment that you would like to grade. In this case, it is "Journal #1." Click on Journal #1.



5 Click on the name of the student whose journal you would like to read and grade. In this example, it is Demo Student 2.



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6 Read the student's response.
