Development Proposal: Learning Extension ("Pull-through") for "Respironics Strategic Business Planning" Program

Development Proposal:

Project Background

Proficient Learning, LLC has designed, developed and implemented "Respironics Strategic Business Planning," a 2-day face-to-face seminar as professional development for both regional management and pharmaceutical representatives. The goal of this workshop is to assist personnel in the identification of strategic goals and development of a Regional Strategic Business Plan.

Proficient Learning believes that "85% of the learning takes place outside the classroom." To realize this belief, they design their programs incorporating both preand post-activities. These learning extensions, or "pull-through" activities, are designed to sustain learning after the workshop has ended, thereby establishing an environment where continuous learning is actualized.

After a careful analysis of the "Respironics Strategic Business Planning" and meeting with both the President and the CEO of Proficient Learning, it was determined that, while the Respironics program utilized effective methods for the face-to-face environment, a strategy for the "pull-through" activity, the creation of the Individual Strategic Business Plan, had not been fully developed. Currently, the only guidance that participants are given is through the use of a workbook, distributed and used during the seminar. Officials at Proficient Learning would like to develop a multimedia solution for this learning extension.

For this project, in accordance with Proficient Learning's needs and an analysis of instructional materials, an autorun CD-ROM will be developed to extend participants' learning beyond the classroom environment. Proficient Learning will distribute this CD-ROM to workshop participants at a determined time after the training. The "pull-through" materials will include a review of concepts from the workshop, activities to stimulate reflection and a template that will assist participants in the creation of the Individual Strategic Business Plan as outlined in the face-to-face workshop. These materials will not only assist representatives in the creation of the document, but also regional management in holding them accountable for the content and strategies learned in the seminar.

The goal of this project will be to develop "pull-through" instructional materials that will be distributed in CD format to participants after completing the "Respironics Strategic Business Planning" workshop.

Discussion of Graphical Representation and Project Proposal

Existing Components:

Currently, Proficient Learning has as developed face-to-face learning module and preworkshop activities. The scope of this project does not include development work on the existing components.

Technical Components:

Autorun CD and Non-linear Menu

• An executable command will be programmed onto the CD so that, when inserted, users are immediately taken to the main menu (developed using Captivate or PowerPoint) or a splash screen that introduces the learning extension. In the event that running executables is disabled on their computers, users will be able to access the materials using the Windows Explorer application.

• The main menu will appear providing users with navigation options. This will assist them in navigating to either a conceptual review of each topic, a reflective activity (a word template that they will save to their desktop and edit), or the Individual Strategic Business Planning template.

Flash or PowerPoint Presentation

- The Flash or PowerPoint presentation will be used as the interface, or shell, for the "pull-through" (learning extension). It will contain both review materials and buttons leading to reflective activities.
- Reflective activities will be prefaced with instructions regarding saving a copy of the template and the activity instructions, using graphics from the review materials.

Graphical Representations

- Graphical representations will be developed using Adobe Fireworks to support learning from the face-to-face environment and will be identified by both the developer and supervisor. A maximum of two (2) new graphics will be developed per unit.
- Graphics will include clip art and/or flow charts/graphic organizers.

Reflective Template

- The reflective activity template will be developed using existing course materials and will be adapted to fit the new module and format (i.e. headings, instructions, and text placement).
- The reflective activity template will be created using Microsoft Word and will include form elements in order to protect the document from user errors.
- The reflective activity template will be accessed by users either through the presentational materials or using Windows Explorer.
- Once saved, users will be able to access the document from their desktop.

Strategic Plan Template

- The Strategic Plan template will be developed using existing course materials and will be adapted to fit the new module and format (i.e. headings, instructions, and text placement).
- The Strategic Plan template will be created using Microsoft Word and will include form elements in order to protect the document from user errors.
- The reflective activity template will be accessed by users either through the presentational materials or using Windows Explorer.
- Once saved, users will be able to access the document from their desktop.

Instructional Components:

Goal of Learning Extension

- The overall goal of this "pull-through" activity is to assist learners in the creation of an Individual Strategic Business Plan.
- Subsequent goals will be to:
 - Review previously learned content from classroom instruction.
 - Apply concepts and processes from development of the Regional Strategic Business Plan to the Individual Strategic Business Plan.
 - Assist participants in reflecting on their short-term and long-term planning.

Conceptual Review

- The conceptual reviews will be included in each unit.
- The goal of the conceptual reviews is to assist learners in processing information learned in the face-to-face seminar, but also extend their learning by applying it to their individual situations.
- Conceptual reviews will serve as a means to establish the Strategic Business Planning process at the individual level as it has been established regionally.

Reflective Activities

- Reflective activities will be created to assist learners in the cognitive construction of an Individual Strategic Business Plan that aligns with the previously created Regional Strategic Business Plan.
- Reflective activities will consist of levels of questioning designed to relate trained concepts from the Regional Business Planning seminar to participants at a personal level. The overall questions for the reflective activities will revolve around, "How does this relate to my current professional situation?" Examples of these questions are:
 - o What is my current business environment?
 - o How do my customers view my service to them?
 - o What are my current resources?
 - o How am I competing with other professionals in my field?
 - o What are my professional strengths?
 - o What threats exist in my current environment?
 - What opportunities exist that can help to improve my performance?
- Responses to reflective questions will be documented using the saved Reflective Activity Template(s).

Individual Strategic Plan Development

- The development of the Individual Strategic Business Plan will be the culminating activity in the learning extension.
- The template described in the *Technical Components* section of this document will be used.
- Responses to the reflective questions will be used in the development of strategic goals for the Individual Strategic Business Plan.
