	<p>Location: Graveyard where Blair Thompson is buried.</p> <p>LS-Keith Thompson walking to daughters grave Truck to right Stop at grave</p> <p>Zoom In Close up-Gravestone</p> <p>Cut</p> <p>Editing Note: Superimpose picture of Blair Thompson over Gravestone</p> <p>Fade out</p>	<p>Keith Thompson: But in fact, these numbers are much higher. These are the numbers of U.S. men, women and children who lost their lives because of the growing drug epidemic in this country. Some were victims of drivers on drugs or drug related violence. Some were the victims of a choice they made when they were just a child to try partying with their friends.</p> <p>I know... because my beautiful daughter Blair was one of those people.</p>

	<p>Dissolve In</p> <p>MCU of Justin's Mom looking out at the ocean.</p> <p>PAN Right up the coast line and Zoom to a wave or surfer.</p> <p>DISSOLVE IN</p> <p>Medium long shot of empty surfboard being washed ashore.</p> <p>Cut</p>	<p>Justin's Mom (voice over): A letter to Justin from his Mom on her memories – his love for family friends, surfing. What it is like to find out how he died)</p> <p>(Continue above with letter telling Justin what his death left behind.)</p>
	<p>Cut in</p> <p>Extreme Close Up: Side Face of Justin's Mom looking away from camera</p> <p>Cut</p>	<p>Justin's Mom: Drugs took away my beautiful son and I'm Mad</p>
	<p>Cut in</p> <p>Two other mothers</p> <p>Cut</p>	<p>Moms: Drugs took ours son and we're mad.</p>

	<p>Cut in Interior, Evening, Thompson Home</p> <p>MS Mr. and Mrs. Thompson holding hands on the couch</p> <p>Dissolve</p>	<p>Mom: Because of drugs and the dealers who sell them we will never dance at our daughters wedding or hold our grandchild in our arms.</p> <p>Both Parents: And we are so mad!</p>
	<p>External, Daytime: The Beach beside a sign dedicated to three of the boys lost to drugs.</p> <p>Group LS</p> <p>D.A.M.M.A.D.D. parents from region who are available all holding pictures of their children.</p> <p>Keith Thompson steps forward</p> <p>Justin's Mom steps forward.</p>	<p>We are all Dammadd!</p> <p>Keith Thompson: Drug dealers killed a child loved by every parent here and so many more who could not be with us today. Drug dealers and the poison they deal stole away our hopes, our dreams and our hearts. So we have started Dammadd. Dads and Mad Moms Against Drug Dealers.</p> <p>We are working together to enact tough new legislation to hold dealers of any drug responsible for all deaths in the area caused by that drug. We need your help. Please go online to Dammadd.org and sign the Blair Thompson act. That's D A M M A D D .org</p> <p>Justin's Mom: And to all of you out there who are asking yourselves the question. I wonder what it would be like just to try a little? 	<p>Fade In</p> <p>Exterior, Daylight, Kure Beach</p> <p>LS The DAMMADD parents</p> <p>Fade out</p>	<p>All Parents: Choose life. Say No!</p>
